American Audio's TT Record Turntable Transforms Old Records Into Digital MP3 Files Without Requiring A Computer, Software or Someone With An Engineering Degree

Ever wish you could hear the B side of the first Rolling Stones record you ever bought? Or enjoy that obscure Queen album you bought in college? Now you can take those old records off the shelf! They no longer have to sit there by themselves gathering dust, because there's a new turntable that almost magically transforms 33 and 45 rpm records into digital files so they can be enjoyed on MP3 and CD players as well as computers.

American Audio's new TT Record looks like a traditional belt-driven turntable

from the outside, and it is -- but it's also a digital recording device. When a vinyl record is placed on the turntable's platter and played, its contents can be recorded and stored as an MP3 file on a USB memory stick or SD card. This makes it possible for anyone to enjoy favorite old records that they thought they'd never play again after their last turntable was retired.

The TT Record transfers analog recordings to 128 kbps MP3 files. However, anyone who wants to upgrade a TT Record to record MP3 files at 192 kbps or at 256kbps can download the zip file "TT

Record 192/256 Update" on the American Audio website, and just follow the upgrade instructions.



A completely standalone unit, the TT Record doesn't require a computer or additional software to do its job. Anyone, even the most technologically challenged, can use it to get their old rock and roll records rolling again. In fact, transforming vinyl to digital with the TT Record is as simple as 1—2 – 3. Just, place the old record on the turntable's platter, insert a USB memory stick or SD card into the built-in slot, press the record button – and as quickly as you can say "Rock 'n Roll Will Never Die," your old vinyl track has

been recorded in a digital format.

Plug in headphones or hook the TT Record to speakers and you can listen to records as you record them to a digital format. A convenient On/Off Record Button allows you to create track breaks easily.

Other features include a +/- 10% Pitch slider, a needle included (headshell and cartridge), a 45 RPM adapter, a slip mat, switchable voltage (115V/60Hz or 230V/50Hz).
